# Day One | Seville - An Amazing and Historical Arrival

### Day Four | A Day of Heritage and Indulgence in Córdoba

Begin your day in Córdoba with a guided visit to the breathtaking Mosque-Cathedral and its historic surroundings, where layers of Roman, Islamic, and Christian history come to life. After exploring the old Jewish Quarter and charming nearby streets, we drive into the Montilla-Moriles wine region for a special visit to one of its most prestigious wineries. Enjoy a leisurely lunch paired with a curated tasting of their finest wines in a beautiful vineyard setting. In the late afternoon, return to Córdoba for a rejuvenating Hammam experience—soaking in warm, aromatic baths that echo the city's Moorish past. The day concludes with a delightful dinner, celebrating the flavors and spirit of Andalusia.

#### Day Five | From Córdoba to Málaga: A Journey Through History and Flavor

The day begins in Córdoba with visits to the Caliphate Baths and the impressive Roman Temple, uncovering the city's rich Roman and Islamic roots. 
# Day Six | Romance and Wine in Ronda: A Day Trip from Málaga

### Day Seven | A Day of Majesty and Magic in Granada

We depart early for Granada, where the day begins with a guided visit to the monumental Alhambra complex, including the elegant Carlos V Palace and the exquisite Nasrid Palaces—masterpieces of Islamic architecture and artistry. After soaking in centuries of history, enjoy a relaxing lunch in a local restaurant. In the afternoon, wander the cobbled streets of the Albaicín or Realejo neighborhoods, full of Moorish charm and hidden corners. Depending on your preference, visit the traditional Arabian baths for a moment of calm, or experience the passion of an authentic flamenco show. As the day winds down, we'll gather for a scenic picnic at a viewpoint overlooking the Alhambra, just in time to watch the sunset paint the city in golden hues. The evening is yours to enjoy at leisure.

# **Morocco Tour - 3 days**

# DAY One | Tangiers - An International hub full of Magic

Arrival in Tangier. Located at the crossroads of **Europe and Africa**, where the **Mediterranean Sea** meets the **Atlantic Ocean**, Tangier has long been a meeting point of cultures, trade, and ideas. We will enjoy a traditional Moroccan meal at one of the local restaurants. Afterwards, we will head to the Kasbah (old town), to explore its narrow winding streets, and take in panoramic views of the city and the Mediterranean Sea from the walls. It's a great spot for photos and discovering Tangier's rich history. We will check in to our hotel in the late afternoon, allowing you to unwind after a day of travel. If you wish to, you can have a quick dip in the hotel pool or rest. Dinner will be served at a local restaurant specializing in traditional Moroccan cuisine.

### DAY Two | Asilah + Chefchouen + Mint Tea Experience

We will start the day by driving to Asilah, a charming coastal town known for its whitewashed buildings and murals and its fortress (also called the Medina Walls), where you can enjoy panoramic views of the Atlantic and explore the quiet, artistic town center. We'll have lunch at a local restaurant, a place renowned for its stunning sea view and relaxed atmosphere. We will then head to Chefchouen to marvel at its colors, though a stroll in the city's narrow, winding streets, lined with blue-painted buildings, to capture the beauty of Chefchaouen's vibrancy with a stunning mountain backdrop. After soaking in the charm of Chefchaouen, we will head back towards Tangier. Later in the afternoon, we'll have a quintessential Moroccan experience: to prepare and sip on brewed **mint tea** paired with **traditional pastries** such as baklava or chebakia. After tea & pastries it's time for cocktails & dinner.



# **DAY Three | Tangiers + Ceuta + Seville**

Day to leave Morocco and head towards Spain. This will not happen before we have a Hamann Experience in Tangiers. After lunch, we will head towards the city of Ceuta (a Spanish enclave on the Moroccan Coast that the Portuguese previously conquered).
