Moving south, we embrace the Atlantic at Nazaré, where you can unwind along its stunning sea coast before continuing to the fairytale village of Óbidos. Here, the charm of medieval streets meets the flavors of locally produced wines and traditional liqueurs.

Throughout the journey, you'll savor curated tastings at some of Portugal's most renowned estates—from bold northern reds to elegant coastal whites—each offering a deeper understanding of the country's diverse and world-class wine culture.

We conclude in vibrant Lisbon, the perfect finale of color, culture, and unforgettable gastronomy.

If you're seeking a journey filled with heritage, coastline beauty, and outstanding wine experiences, this tour is for you. Come raise a glass to Portugal with us!

### **Day One | Arrival & Short Porto Tour for Newcomers**

Pick-up at the Airport. A small walk to the most beautiful bookstore in the world (Livraria Lello), an inspiration for Harry Potter's writer (J.K. Rowling)



followed by a small walk to one of the highlights of Portuguese tile artistry: the São Bento Train Station. Afterwards, we will have lunch and then check into your hotel, near the UNESCO World Heritage Area of downtown Ribeira. Other sites in the area will be visited, namely some of its shops with handcrafted jewelry and Portuguese art, or you can choose to rest. Dinner will be at one of Porto's most traditional restaurants.

### **Day Two | Medieval Porto & Guimarães | The Birth Cradle of Portugal**

The morning will be free for you to relax and enjoy some of the Hotel's amenities such as the gym, pool or the spa, before we head out to the other side of the Douro riverbank, walking the cobblestone streets and crossing King Luís I bridge by foot to Vila Nova de Gaia, where we will lunch at one of the oldest Porto winemakers. Here you will also experience a wine tasting and then we will take a drive to the historical and quaint town of Guimarães (a UNESCO World Heritage Site). This is Portugal's cradle as a nation (since 1143). We will stroll its streets and squares and visit the main church and castle. Dinner will be at a quaint restaurant in the city center. Afterwards, we will be back to Porto.

### **Day Three | From Wine to Surfing |**

What is quite interesting about Portugal is how quickly one can arrive to different destinations that have no resemblance at all with each other. You will experience that today. We will start by heading to Coimbra to visit its university and one of its amazing places: the 17th-century library, where books



are best friends with bats. After having lunch, we will arrive at the surf style, world-renowned big wave Mecca of Nazaré, where world record gigantic waves are surfed. On our way to the Hotel, we'll stop in the quaint & historical town of Óbidos to stroll and shop through its walled streets and castle. We will arrive at our hotel in Santa Cruz and have dinner at the village restaurant.

#### **Day Four | Relax & Enjoy**

The morning will be free to enjoy at your own pace. After lunch, you can continue enjoying the amenities or visit the Alcobaça Monastery, a Gothic architectural ensemble where a love story is immortalized by a Portuguese King. We will still have time to taste wine at a magnificent location, before dinner by the sea in Santa Cruz.

#### **Day Five | Lisbon on Sight!**

It is normal to have glorious beach days in June, in Portugal. So, if the weather allows, you can go for an early stroll by the sea or take yourself on an adventure in the ocean for a surf lesson or a yoga session. These are options available at the hotel to enjoy before lunch. After lunch at a quaint, traditional restaurant, we will stop at the westernmost tip of Europe (Roca Cape). You will be at the most western point of the European continent, which makes you closer to the United States than any other place in Europe. Afterwards, it will be time for a wine tasting, before taking a scenic view to Lisbon, going across places such as Estoril and Cascais, known as the Portuguese Riviera. Arriving in Lisbon, we will check in at the hotel and move to the Bairro Alto neighborhood for dinner.



### **Day Six | Lisbon - The Icons!**

We will start our day by the river at the Belém Tower, Jerónimos Monastery and the Discoveries Monument. We will have lunch near the city square and visit the Lisbon Cathedral (the oldest church in town). We will stroll to the Terreiro do Paço Square and through what is known as Baixa Pombalina, built after the 1775 Lisbon Earthquake and one of the first European examples of Enlightenment urban development. Afterwards, time to relax will come with a wine tasting at one of the trendiest wine bars in Lisbon, which will be followed by a free evening.

### **Day Seven | Royal Lisbon & Shopping Time**

In the morning, we will drive to the Ajuda National Palace, where, not only will we visit its royal chambers and Throne Hall, but we will also have time to see the Royal Treasure Museum, where some of the royal jewels can be seen. We will have lunch at a restaurant with the most impressive view of Lisbon. After lunch, we will head to one of the iconic wine producers in the Lisbon area for another amazing wine experience. If time allows, we will still spend time shopping around some of the iconic and more traditional shops in Lisbon, which have been a staple of the city's charm for generations.
